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"I Believe..."

Lincoln Charter School will be implementing the Roar for Peace Bullying Prevention Program for the 2016-2017 school year. Our Director of Community Outreach currently conducts trainings with the Bullying Prevention Coordinating Committee (BPCC) during the 2016-2017 school year. The BPCC members train the Lincoln Charter School staff on the four components of the program: School Level Component, Classroom Level Component, Individual Level Component, and the Community Level Component.

The program is described as a whole-school program that will prevent and reduce bullying throughout the Lincoln Charter School, prevent the development of new bullying problems, and improve peer relations within the school setting.

Roar for Peace uses trainings for staff, who then provide lessons for students that are aligned to Common Core Standards. **Trainings for staff include online courses, webinars, and in-person program implementation seminars.** The lessons for students include: recognizing bullying, warning signs of bullying, the impact of bullying, bullying and sexual orientation, cyber bullying, and bullying prevention/intervention. Students are specifically taught how to both identify bullying and seek positive interventions when bullying occurs.
